2009 Graduate Survey for Associate's Degree Graduates  
Executive Abstract

- ❖ This survey was administered online to the 2009 Associates degree graduates between April and August 2009. Over 90% of the graduates responded to the survey.
- ❖ Out of the graduates that responded 12% reported concentrations in CIS, 19% in Accounting and 69% in Business Administration.
- ❖ 88% of the domestic respondents were employed, continuing their education or temporarily unavailable for work.

Out of the employed domestic respondents:

- ❖ 58% found work to be directly or somewhat related to their major course of study, 60% of the others chose to take employment outside of their related field.
- ❖ 50% were very or somewhat satisfied with their current job.
- ❖ 75% of all graduates were interested in pursuing a B.S. degree with 25% saying they would consider GBC for the B.S. program.
- ❖ Average time to complete Associate's degree program: 1.81 year.

Executive Abstract

- ❖ This survey was administered online to the 2009 Bachelors degree graduates between April and August 2009. Over 95% of the graduates responded to the survey.
- ❖ Out of the graduates that responded 23% were in Accounting, 26% in Management, 12% in Human Resource Management, 4% in Finance, 6% in Business Administration, 18% in Marketing, 2% in Computer Information Systems, 3% in Accounting and Information Systems, 4% in International Business Management, and 2% in Management Information Systems.
- ❖ 96% of domestic respondents were employed, continuing their education or temporarily unavailable for work.

Out of the employed domestic respondents:

- ❖ 81% found work to be directly or somewhat related to their major course of study (versus 73% in 2008), 53% of the others chose to take employment outside of their related field.
- ❖ 81% were very or somewhat satisfied with their current job (versus 79% in 2008).
- ❖ 44% were employed with a large employer (over 500 employees) (versus 48% in 2008), with 24% of them working in the financial industry. (Included A.S. graduates).
- ❖ Of the respondents who were employed full time, reported salary ranges were: 6% under \$20K; 22% at \$20-29K; 25% at \$30-39K; 8% at \$40-49K; 3% at \$50-59K; 15% at \$60K and above. 21% did not report their salary.
- ❖ Of the 99 respondents who listed their employers, 80 employers were represented. The top employers for the 2009 graduates were: JPMorgan Chase (5), Bank of America (4), Goldey-Beacom College (4), BarclayCard (4), and Barbacane Thornton & Associates (3) (Includes A.S. graduates).
- ❖ 62% of all graduates were interested in pursuing MBA degree (up from 53% in 2008 with 39% saying they would consider GBC for the MBA program, up from 27% in 2008).
- ❖ Average time to complete Bachelor's degree program: 3.267 years.

**Executive Abstract**

- ❖ This survey was administered online to all 2009 Master degree students, with over 95% of the Masters students responding. The survey was conducted between April and August 2009.
- ❖ Out of the master's graduates who responded, 47% reported concentrations in Finance, 9% in Information Technology, 14% in Comprehensive, 10% in Marketing, 10% in Masters of Management, and 10% in Human Resources Management.
- ❖ Of the domestic respondents, 100% were employed, continuing their education, or temporarily unavailable for work.

Out of the employed domestic respondents:

- ❖ 91% were employed full time.
- ❖ 87% found work directly or somewhat related to their course of study (versus 80% in 2008), 71% of the others chose to take employment outside of their related field.
- ❖ 42% of the respondent's employers considered their position to be management level (versus 40% in 2008).
- ❖ 84% perceive opportunities for advancement in their jobs (versus 67% in 2008).
- ❖ 82% were very satisfied or somewhat satisfied with their current job (versus 69% in 2008).
- ❖ Of the respondents who were employed full-time, salary ranges were: 2% were below \$30K; 14% at \$30-40K; 18% at \$40-50K; 5% at \$50-60K; 11% at \$60-70K; and 23% at \$70K and above. 25% did not report their salary.
- ❖ 62% were employed at large employers (over 500 employees) with 32% working in the financial industry (versus 60% at large employers and 29% in the financial industry in 2008).
- ❖ Out of the 92 respondents who listed their employer, 64 companies were represented. The top employers for the master degree 2009 graduates include: PNC (6), Discover (5), JPMorgan Chase (5), AstraZeneca (4), Bank of America (3), and Connective Energy (3).
- ❖ Average time to complete a Master's degree program 1.1 year.
