**This form allows a student to defer tuition payment from May 1, 2008, until October 1, 2008, for Summer 2008 classes.** The student is expected to receive a grade of "C" or above in each class and be eligible for a tuition reimbursement program with his/her employer for the Summer 2008 session.

To request a deferral for the summer tuition payment, the student must submit this form to the Business Office by May 1, 2008. A \$100 payment will automatically be charged to the credit card account listed below unless an alternate method of payment is made when this form is received in the Business Office. This payment will be applied to the student's summer balance, reducing the total amount being deferred.

**The Deferred Payment Amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ will be charged to the charge card listed below on October 1, 2008.** The student may choose to pay the Deferred Payment Amount prior to October 1, 2008, with another form of payment if the student prefers. Should the charge card be declined when processed for payment on October 1, 2008, a \$100 late payment fee will be assessed and charged to the student's account at the College. Should the student add or drop a course, the Deferred Payment Amount will be adjusted accordingly.

**I agree to the following rules of the Tuition Deferral Agreement:**

- Goldey-Beacom College is authorized to charge the credit card listed below on the date on which this form is submitted and on October 1, 2008.
- If payment cannot be successfully processed on October 1, 2008, all scheduled classes that have not begun by that date will be dropped.
- **Payment is expected by the due date whether or not reimbursement funds have been received from the employer.**
- Grades will be available on Campus Web shortly after the end of each session. It is the student's responsibility to provide the employer with grades and other required documentation for reimbursement.
- Grades will be reviewed at the end of each session. Any student with a grade(s) below a "C" will have his/her student account placed "on-hold" and sent a statement for immediate payment. Being on-hold also prevents the student's official academic records from being released until the balance has been cleared.
- Collection costs and/or legal fees up to and including 50% may be charged to the student account in the collection of a delinquent balance.
- Students are eligible for the TD program if no outstanding debt is owed to the College and previous payments were made accordingly.
