**2007 Graduate Survey for AS/BS Graduates**  
**Executive Abstract**

- ⇒ This survey was administered on-line to the 2007 Associates and Bachelors degree graduates between April and August 2007. Nearly 90% of the graduates responded to the survey.
- ⇒ Out of the graduates that responded 17% reported concentrations in Management, 15% in Marketing, 23% in Accounting, 11% in Human Resource Management, 9% in Finance, 3% in Accounting and Information Systems, 5% in Business Administration, 4% in International Business Management, 8% in Computer Information Systems and 4% in Management Information Systems.
- ⇒ 95% of domestic respondents were employed or continuing their education.

Out of the employed domestic respondents:

- ⇒ 77% found work to be directly or somewhat related to their major course of study.
- ⇒ 67% were very or somewhat satisfied with their current job.
- ⇒ 53% were employed with a large employer (over 500 employees), with 20% of them working in the banking industry.
- ⇒ Of the respondents who were employed full time, 45% reported earning \$30,000 or higher per year and 26% reported earning \$40,000 or higher per year, with 10% not reporting a salary.
- ⇒ Of the 172 respondents who listed their employers, 107 were represented. The top employers for the 2007 graduates were: Bank of America (10), DuPont (3), JP Morgan Chase (11), GBC (3) and Wilmington Trust (4).
- ⇒ 81% of all graduates were interested in pursuing a MBA degree (up from 78.7% in 2006 and up from 79.3% in 2005) with 84% saying they would consider GBC for the MBA program.
- ⇒ 90% of the graduates were aware of the services offered through the career services department (down from 93% in 2006 and up from 87.2% in 2005).
- ⇒ 11% of the respondents were International Students.

Out of the domestic students who responded:

⇒ 51% were Evening Students.

⇒ 49% were Day Students.

⇒ The International Students were not tallied in the placement rate since many were not able to work legally, were waiting for their OPT authorization, or returning to their home country post graduation.

**2007 Masters Graduate Survey**  
**Executive Abstract**

⇒ This survey was administered on-line to all 2007 Master degree students, with over 90% of the Masters students responding. The survey was conducted in April through to August 2007.

⇒ Out of the master's graduates who responded, 36% reported concentrations in Finance, 20% in Comprehensive, 16% in Marketing, 14% in Masters of Management, 8% in Human Resource Management and 5% in Information Technology.

⇒ Of the domestic respondents, 91% were working full time or continuing their education.

Out of the employed domestic respondents:

⇒ 100% were employed full time.

⇒ 76% found work directly or somewhat related to their course of study.

⇒ 32% of the respondent's employers considered their position to be management level.

⇒ 51% perceive opportunities for advancement in their jobs.

⇒ 65% were very satisfied or somewhat satisfied with their current job.

⇒ 47% of the graduates reported earning over \$50,000 per year with 11% not reporting their salary data.

⇒ 64% were employed at large employers (over 500 employees) with 33% working in the banking industry.

⇒ Out of the 80 respondents who listed their employer, 55 companies were represented. The top employers for the masters degree 2007 graduates include: Bank of America (9), JP Morgan Chase (7), GBC (3), Wilmington Trust Company (4).

⇒ 29% of the respondents were International Students.

⇒ The International Students were not tallied in the placement rate since many were not able to work legally, were waiting their OPT authorization or returning to their home country post graduation.
