Program Details

- All Goldey-Beacom courses are offered in-person and within the high school instructional day.
- Courses are offered on the high school campus and transition to the college campus during junior/senior years.
- Transportation is available to GBC for college campus courses.
- All students in the Early College Academy are enrolled in an ECA Support Class throughout their time in the program.
- Students must apply through the Delaware School Choice process at www.schoolchoicede.org between November 6, 2023, and January 10, 2024. Families must first select either "Thomas McKean High School" or "Alexis I. du Pont High School" and then select "Early College Academy".
- While there is no prerequisite for incoming 9th graders, students must maintain a 2.8 unweighted cumulative GPA to continue in the program from year to year.
- Students who complete the Early College Academy program are eligible for an annual \$4,000 merit scholarship to attend Goldey-Beacom.
