Student Address – Micah White, Class of 2024

Micah White was born in Paterson, New Jersey and moved around within Central New Jersey until finally landing in Edison. This is where he graduated from Edison High School in 2020 with his diploma and an unconventional, outdoor graduation.

In February 2020, Micah signed his national letter of intent to run for Goldey-Beacom College's Cross Country and Track & Field teams. After visiting the small, quiet campus and speaking with energetic coaches, he had decided that Pike Creek, Delaware would be his future home.

While Micah isn't wearing one of his many hats on-campus, he enjoys writing poetry and short stories, recording music, 'crate-digging' for new music, and photography. Though he enjoys the social aspects of his jobs on-campus and being surrounded by friends, he revels in introspective thinking about his next goal in life.

He currently works as a Resident Assistant, an Athletic Student Worker, and a Peer Mentor for the First-Year Experience Program, all at Goldey-Beacom College. Concurrently, Micah is also the President of the Black Student Union, a division II athlete, and a member of Lightning Studios (amongst other commitments). Through these connections, it's been possible for him to achieve greater on-campus and elsewhere. He wants to thank all who've helped him along his four-year journey. Furthermore, he'd like to send a special thank you to Jocelyn Moses, Dean of Students, for providing a sense of major encouragement, as a mentor, and the entirety of the English department for inspiring him to continue his pursuit of mastery in writing. Micah would also like to send much appreciation to his parents, Brian and Nicole White, his siblings, his friends, and the entire GBC community.

Notable Awards that Micah has received during his time at GBC include the Division II ADA Academic Achievement Award, the Dean's and President's Lists, 2x Captain of the Men's Cross-Country team, and the President's Award for Achieving Greater.

After graduation, Micah intends to pursue his master's degree in English while working as an Assistant Resident Director at Duquesne University in the Fall of 2024. Beacom Greater!

Keynote Speaker— Howard Eskin, Sports Broadcaster for SportsRadio 94 WIP

Howard Eskin is SportsRadio 94 WIP's original sports talker. Not only did he launch the station's very first sports talk show on 610 WIP in 1986, but when the station switched its dial position to 94.1FM in 2011, his was the first show on the air. He has broadcast nearly 7,000 shows on WIP, more than any other sports talker in the country.

Today, in addition to hosting the station's top-rated Saturday morning talk show and appearing frequently on air throughout the week, Eskin co-hosts the station's Eagles pre-game shows and serves as sideline reporter for the Philadelphia Eagles radio broadcasts. Eskin ranks being on the air from the field during the Eagles legendary 2018 Super Bowl win as the best experience of his storied sports broadcasting career.

Dubbed the market's "hardest working sportscaster" by local media for his eternal hustle on the job, Eskin has broken more sports stories than any one broadcaster in the Philadelphia market. In addition to his dominant radio presence, he has excelled as a multi-media personality throughout his career. In addition to his local television positions, Eskin has been a frequent guest along with being a regular guest host on "The Dan Patrick Show" broadcast nationally on radio and TV, while also appearing on The NFL Network.

The two-time Emmy-Award winning sportscaster first made the transition from radio to television in 1982 when he joined CBS 3 (KYW-TV). True to form, Eskin broke a major story less four months into his TV career, reporting that Eagles owner Leonard Tose was planning to sell, and then move the team out of town. One of his managers at KYW even credits the sportscaster with keeping the Eagles in Philadelphia. "If Howard had not stepped in when he did, Leonard Tose would have snuck the Eagles out of town," says Frank Traynor.

Eskin later helped launch Fox29's (WTFX-TV) Ten O'clock News as part of its original anchor team in 1986. Later, he rejoined KYW-TV in 1992 and then moved to WCAU-TV in 1996 where he hosted the station's Sunday night sports show, Sports Final. In 2012, he rejoined FOX29 where he remains a host during football season. Eskin had also been a contributor to the George Michael Sports Machine on NBC, co-hosted a nationally syndicated radio show, Let's Talk Sports, written a column for the Philadelphia Daily News and has been called on for his opinions by such diverse programs as NBC's Today Show and PBS's MacNeil Lehrer Newshour.

Throughout his career, this Philadelphia native and Northeast High grad (where he is featured on the school's Wall of Fame), has used his celebrity to raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for local charities, including The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, The Terri Lynne Lykoff Child Care Foundation, The Cystic Fibrosis Foundation and The National Multiple Sclerosis Society through sales of his own signature bobble head.

Among his many honors, The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society named him "Man of the Year" in 2002 and the March of Dimes named Eskin its "Media Person of the Year" in 2003. In 2007, Eskin was inducted into the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame. In 2010, he received the March of Dimes prestigious Lifetime Achievement Award for Achievement in Radio. In 2012, Eskin was inducted into the Broadcast Pioneers' Hall of Fame. In 2014, he was inducted into the Philadelphia Jewish Sports Hall of Fame.
